

ACTS 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

According to Ephesians 1:13-14, *13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. It is the presence of the Spirit in our lives that guarantees that we are saved for all eternity. He is also the seal of ownership that assure us that we belong to God's awesome spiritual family called the Church. His presence also makes us heirs of the amazing spiritual heritage of blessing which God promised to His people! While we wait for the time when we get to heaven, the Holy Spirit guide us in our spiritual journey and gives the power so that we can share God's love with others and make a difference in this world! Pastor Jon taught us that,

The Holy Spirit is our inner voice that helps us to follow God. John 16:8.

The Holy Spirit is our teacher. Psalm 18:28

The Holy Spirit is our guide . John 16:13, Isaiah 30:21 & 23

The Holy Spirit is our friend. John 14:16, 2 Corinthians 13:14

The Holy Spirit is our power. Acts 1:8, Acts 2:41.

It was the Holy Spirit that made the early church so powerful and effective. We believe that the Holy Spirit still works in and through believers to accomplish His will. His power leads us, convicts us, teaches us, and equips us to do His work and share Jesus with others the gospel. It is the Holy Spirit who will make our lives effective!
