



HANG OUT (10 MINS)

- Welcome people as they arrive!
- Spend a few minutes making small talk/offer snacks.

ICE BREAKER (10 MINS)

- Ask three to four people: Would you rather pet a tame lion or a wild lizard? Why?

SERMON DISCUSSION (50 MINS)

- Worship and Prayer
- Read Bible verses: Romans 12:2, Proverbs 4:23, Matthew 22:36-37, 1 Peter 5:7-9

Ask DGroup members to share their favorite points from the sermon *SILENCING THE LIZARD, RESISTING THE LION*, what spoke to them, a phrase or moment from the sermon they related to the most, or questions they have. If members have a hard time recalling the sermon, talk through your notes and share your favorite points.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

RENEWING OUR MINDS

- Who or what is the biggest influence in your life? Why?
- Do you struggle knowing God's will for your life?
- Why do people find it difficult to know God's will for them?
- Based on Romans 12:2, what are we able to receive and perceive when our lives are transformed?

COMMITTING TO THE PROCESS

- Pastor said, the lizard and the lion both lie to us to keep us from changing. Have you ever believed their lie?
- What has been the biggest challenge that keep you from committing to the process of godly transformation and growth?
- How do the lizard and the lion's lies influence your decisions or behavior?
- 1 Peter 5 tells us to be of sober mind. What keeps you from having a sober mind — things that keep you from focusing on God's Word? Why? (e.g., pride, anxiety, arrogance, your own plans, fear, greed, lust, etc.)
- What do you need to do to let go of that so you can have a sober mind and walk in God's truth?

CLOSING ACTIVITY (5 MINS)

- This week, identify where you're hearing roars and where you're believing the lizard. When you hear a roar, stop and think about what 1 Peter 5:8: "*Be alert and of sober mind.*"
- Prayer Requests and Prayer. Ask DGroup members to share any prayer requests they have. Record any notes or prayer requests to pray for members during the week.
