#### Read Proverbs 23:7

- 1. What do you think does this verse mean?
- 2. It is said that our lives move in the direction of our greatest thoughts. Why do you think are thoughts have so much power over our direction?
- 3. Can you share a thought/idea/phobia/dream (pick one) from child-hood that has shaped the way you live?
- 4. Based on question 3, how do we know that we have either won or lost a battle in the mind?

#### Read 2 Corinthians 10:3-5.

- 1. What does the Apostle Paul mean by For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world?
- 2. Read verse 4. What does Paul mean by arguments and pretensions that oppose the knowledge of God? And, what weapons do we have in Christ to fight our spiritual and mental battles (Read Ephesians 6:10-20?
- 3. Read verse 5. Paul reminds us that we have spiritual authority. Pastor Jon mentioned the phrase "take captive" is a military term. What does it mean to take every thought captive and making them submit to Christ?

#### Read 2 Peter 1:3.

1. How does this spiritual authority make you feel about facing the battles in your mind?
